RULES & REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the Current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to interpret all guestions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

WARNING: THE Loudoun Benefit, IT'S MANAGEMENT, OFFICERS, OWNERS, OFFICIALS, AND EMPLOYEES WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT OR LOSS WHICH MAY OCCUR TO AN EXHIBITOR, SPECTATOR, GUEST, RIDER, GROOM, ATTENDANT OR OTHER EMPLOYEE, ANIMAL, VEHICLE, OR EQUIPMENT AT THE SHOW.

THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW OR SHOW GROUNDS.

Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay the \$15.00 USEF Drug/ Medication Fee plus an \$8.00 USEF fee. (Total \$23.00 USEF Fee). Each horse entered will also be required to pay the USHJA Fee of \$7.00.

While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication, the USEF, Grafton and Salem Farm Showgrounds, Loudoun Benefit Horse Show, and its management and/ employees assume no liability to anyone for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted upon their acceptance, and otherwise in accordance with USEF rules.

Credentials: ALL EXHIBITORS IN ANY PONY, JUNIOR HUNTER OR AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR CREDENTIALS

(MEASUREMENT CARD OR AMATEUR CERTIFICATION) TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THEIR NUMBERS CAN BE RELEASED. Kindly send a photo copy of credentials with entry to facilitate processing. All horses or ponies without a valid measurement card will be measured at a designated time and place. Amateur exhibitors not able to present valid Amateur Credentials will be required to join the Federation. EXHIBITORS WHO CANNOT PRODUCE VALID MEMBERSHIP CREDENTIALS MUST PURCHASE A USEF SHOW PASS DIRECTLY THROUGH USEF OR PURCHASE AND ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP AND COMPLETE SAFESPORT TRAINING AS APPLICABLE. A \$30 USHJA SHOW PASS FEE CAN BE INVOICED THROUGH THE HORSE SHOW FOR INACTIVE USHJA MEMBERS. PARENTS SIGNING AS TRAINER FOR THEIR CHILD MUST MEET REQUIREMENTS ABOVE. USEF Competing Members aged 18 or older must have successfully completed SafeSport training prior to competing.

Horse Registrations: All horses competing in Federation nonbreed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Proof of registration must be presented to the Show Secretary before numbers can be released. To be eligible for National, Regional or Zone Horse of the Year Awards, and to enter a USEF Computer Ranking List Class horses must also be registered with the USEF. All horses must have a valid microchip on file with USEF to be eligible to compete in any class.

Coggins Test: Virginia state law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate dated within one year. Out of state horses should be accompanied by a health certificate. This requirement applies to every horse whether stabled, non-showing, or shipping in.

PLEASE BRING A PAPER COPY OF COGGINS, NOT ONE TO BE PRINTED FROM YOUR PHONE.

EHV/Influence Vaccination: Per GR845 proof of vaccination for EHV and Equine Influenza within **six months** of the competition must also accompany each entry. This requirement applies to every horse whether stabled, non-showing, or shipping in.

Entries: The closing date for entries will be **May 13, 2024**. A \$50 late fee will apply to all entries not submitted by the closing date.

Checks (made payable in U.S. Funds) should be made payable to Loudoun Benefit Horse Show. Numbers will not be issued without a signed open check or credit card lodged with the horse show secretary. A non-refundable \$70 Office Processing Fee will be charged to all entries. Exhibitors shall be responsible for the entry fees of all horses entered by them or their agents even though the payment of those fees are not submitted with the entry fees. Entries not closed out by the completion of the horse show may be subject to a \$30 close out fee.

Any disputes found on your printed invoice must be resolved within 24 hours. Please review your bills carefully and note the correct prize money payee on your bill. If disputes are not negotiated within this time period, the invoice will stand.

Credit Cards: Upon initial entry, there will not be a service fee for online entry. If you decide to use a credit card at Checkout, there will be a 5% convenience fee added on the final bill.

RULES & REGULATIONS (cont'd.)

All entries this year need to be submitted ONLINE at

HorseShowsOnline. Entries must be made on the official show 2024 entry blank and include all required information including registration numbers, signatures, and prize payee information. All accounts must be settled in full at the show. A fee of \$50 or 10% whichever is greater will be charged for any returned checks. Unpaid entries will be forwarded to USEF per GR913. For your safety and to reduce paperwork and streamline office work, all entries must be done on HorseShowsOnline.com for the Loudoun Benefit. For adds/scratches, schedules, orders and online bill paying please go to mobile.horseshowsonline.com.

Prize Money: The owner of any horse/pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded MUST provide a social security number or Federal ID number on the entry form. Prize money will be credited to your show account. Any overages will be mailed within 30 days of check-out. In the event of unauthorized redeeming of a check, Loudoun Benefit will provide check copies to exhibitors and will be held harmless from the collection process.

Stalls: Temporary stalls, sized 10'x10' with attached doors on blue stone pad footing will be available for \$325 (non refundable) for the week. Stalls will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Payment via check or credit card must accompany stabling reservation form in order to secure stalls (separate open payment required for entries). **Stalls will not be available for move in until 6/11 Tuesday am.** The stalls are leased to Loudoun Benefit Horse Show and absolutely no subletting or re-selling of stalls is permitted by anyone other than Loudoun Benefit Horse Show. Prior to closing of entries, management will only refund pre-paid stall fees for stalls that can be filled by exhibitors on the official wait list. Stalls that cannot be filled from the wait list will not be refunded.

Night Watch: Individual overnight horse watch services are available. Contact Terry Chatman of Night Eyes Night Watch to arrange for overnight services, 859-489-7892

Ship Ins: Horses not stabled on grounds will be permitted, a \$75 grounds fee will apply.

Non-Showing Horses: All non-showing horses must complete an entry blank, **submit a valid paper copy of your Coggins**, and EHV information. A \$150 fee will be assessed to any horse not entered in any classes.

Motor Homes: A limited number of motor homes and camper sites are available.

Campers should be reserved through the RV Reservation Form on loudounbenefit.org and will be assessed a \$350 fee for the week. All spaces will be assigned and offer 50amp or 30 amp hookups.

Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts: Under Virginia State Laws and USEF rules, unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles – ATVs, motorcycles, golf carts, etc., on the show grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show. See USEF GR 301.

Minor Exhibitors: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid

temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Safe Sport: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef. org.

Protective Headgear: Protective head gear, properly secured, must be worn **BY ALL RIDERS AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED**, anywhere, anytime on the show grounds. Headgear for **all riders** must meet or exceed ASTM Standards; must carry the SEI tag; and be properly secured by a harness per USEF rules.

Sharps: Sharps containers will be provided at the barns. Management may fine exhibitors up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

Dogs: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. **Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions result- ing from their dogs' behaviors.** Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR 301. Failure to maintain your dog, under control, as defined here, will result in a \$50 fine assessed to the owner. In addition, pursuant to facility regulations, loose dogs will be removed by animal control, from the show grounds, at the owner's expense and impounded.

Animal Welfare: Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of the USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse.

RULES & REGULATIONS (cont'd.)

USEF rules defining policy regarding abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off-set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

Parking: Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and passenger vehicles from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or off-load. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND

VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNERS EXPENSE

Equine & Human Safety Fee: Each entry this year will pay a \$30.00 Equine & Human Safety Fee.

COVID 19

The horse show will be adhering to all CDC, Federal and USEF current regulations at the time of the show.

Under Saddles & Jogs

Per USEF, in hand jogs are waived. For any over fences class requiring a jog, the rider will trot a circle on a loose rein after completing the course in the view of the judge. Any model or conformation classes will suggest wearing a mask and to comply with social distancing during judging.

Scratches: Once entered and accepted, no horse may be scratched without a vet certificate. No Stall fees, once accepted and after the close of entries, May 15th, will be refunded. If the entry fee is by division only, no money can be refunded after the start of the division.

- Tuesday schooling will be TICKETED WARMUPS (\$45/round) for all hunter rings. All hunter rings open 9am-4pm. Jumper rings will be open for flatwork ONLY from 9am-3pm.
- Horses not already in stalls for Upperville will NOT be permitted on grounds prior to Tuesday, June 11th, 2024.
- Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis online only.
- There will be no same day adds during show, same day scratches accepted with no penalty.
- If entries are closed a notice will be posted on horseshowsonline.com. If entries are closed substitutions will be permitted but no new entries will be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Ship ins are permitted however no new ship in entries will be permitted if entries are closed.
- Trip counts will be closely monitored to ensure a timely finish to the day; classes may be closed for new entries as rings get full.
- Salem Main Jumper Ring will have posted orders daily. Orders of go will be posted at the show office and on horseshowsonline.com each evening.
- Live ring status displaying each ring's progress will be available throughout the show via horse showsonline.com.
- Stabling forms must be submitted for online entries. Prepayment for all stalls is required to be considered reserved. Special stabling requests will be honored if possible but are not guaranteed.
- Adjustments to stall reservations should be submitted prior to the closing date. Additional stalls requested after the closing date will only be granted if available and may not be next to the main block.



WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and <u>Loudoun Benefit</u> ("USEF Event"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, (i) the propensity of an equine to behave in dangerous ways which may result in injury to the participant; (ii) the inability to predict an equine's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or animals; and (iii) hazards of surface or subsurface conditions; (iv) the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; (v) loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; (vi) accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; (vii) facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); (viii) inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; (ix) situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and (x) other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers. (**"Risks")**.

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.: Under VA Code Ann. Sec 3.2-6200-6203, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.


